Visual Art Exhibition Piece

- All work submitted must have been completed in the last 12 months prior to the competition. (This is a particular subject for review for 2015.)
- Two entries per school: one at Junior and one at Senior.
- Works will be judged on composition, content, control of media, communication of ideas and use of materials. (This is a particular subject for review for 2015.)
- Media can be: painting, design, printmaking and photography. Sculpture is allowed but not recommended due to venue's spacial constraints to display the work and the potential for accidental damage. The host school takes no responsibility for any damage incurred.
- No smaller than A4.
- There is no set theme. (This is a particular subject for review for 2015.)
- The student should submit a brief paragraph explaining his ideas. This should be on card and displayed with the artwork.
- The host school should endeavour to employ two judges.
- All work must be ready for hanging and be in an appropriate frame or canvas.
- Work should be submitted on DAS Exhibition canvas, or similar with a staple-free edge.
- Each student who created the work is encouraged to avail himself in the exhibition area to talk to the judge, public and peers about their creation.
